A driller for Lonmin, and a 28 year-old father, husband and brother



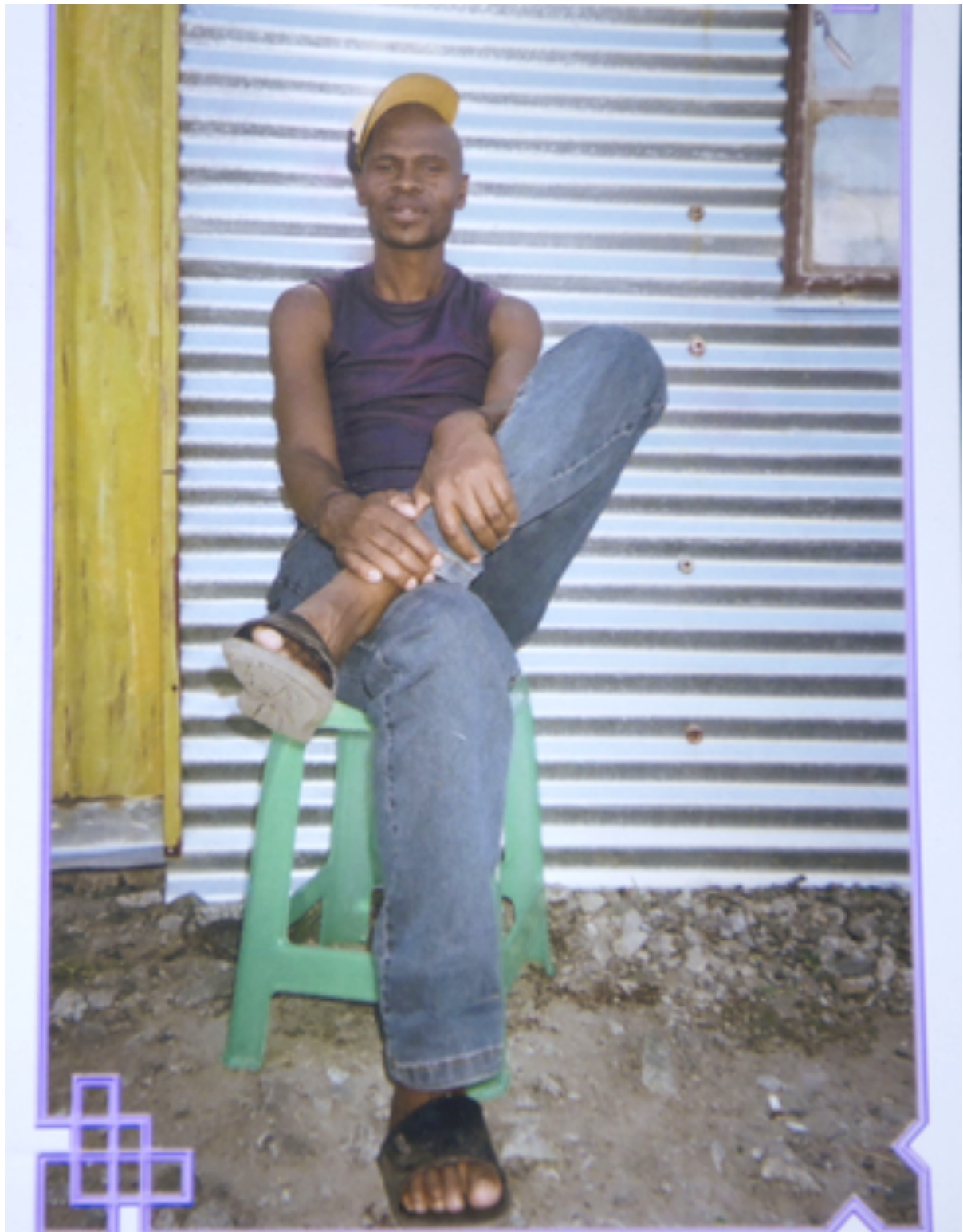
Raphael Janaveke Liao

A 29 year-old with big dreams who was the laughing heart of his family



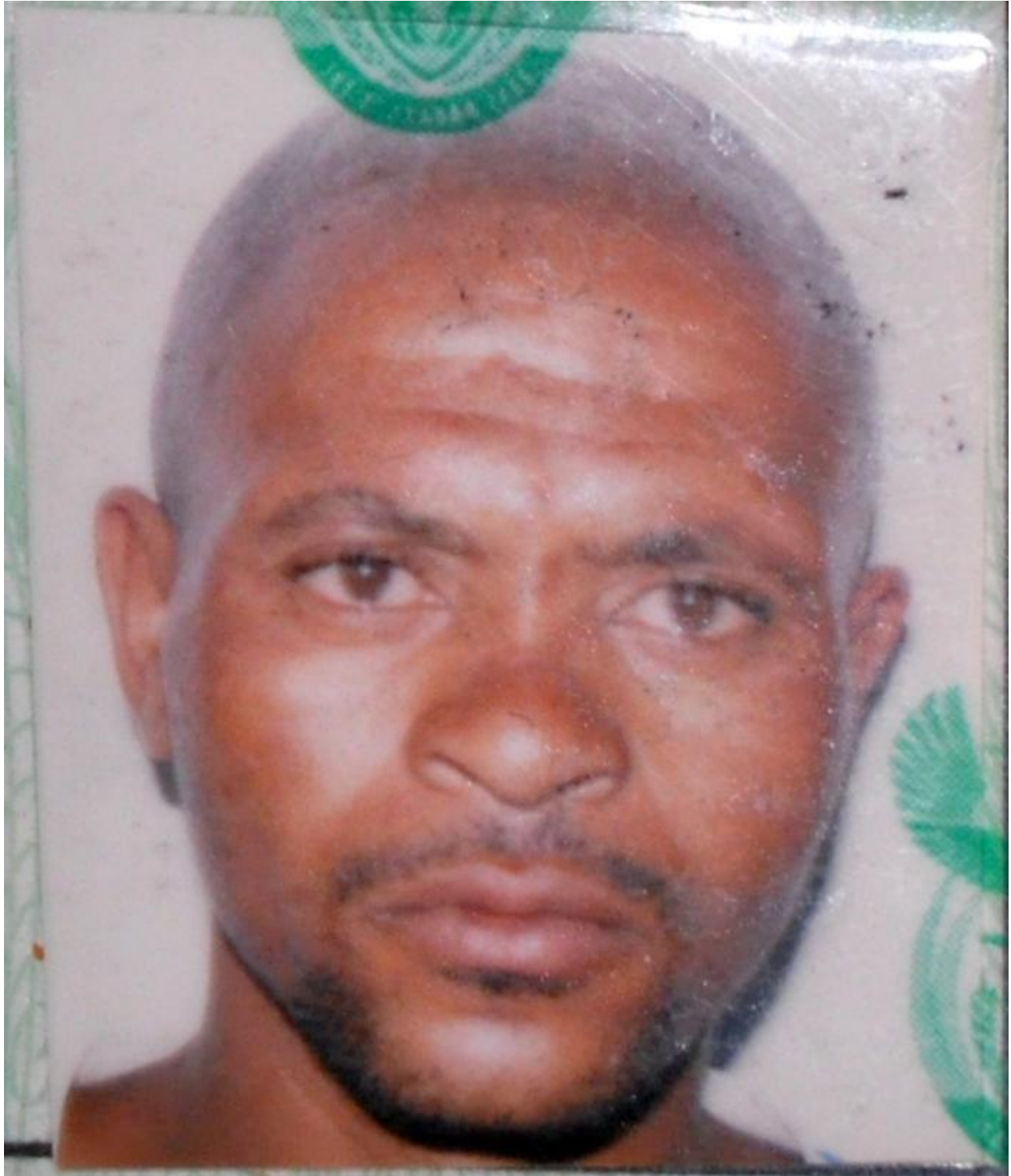
Makhosandile Mkhonjwa

29 years old - 'They have taken the only person we could rely on.'



Mphangeli Tukuza

A 42 year-old operator and respected man. His brothers are demanding to take his place at Lonmin



Mphumzeni Ngxande

A 38 year-old rock drill operator for whom working at Lonmin was his big break



Henry Mvuyisi Pato

35-year old, dedicated to his family.
'He died for all of us on the mines.'



Julius Tokoti Mancotywa

Husband of Nowellington and father
to their eight children.



Mzukisi Sompeta

A 37 year-old rock driller killed by police on August 16, 2012. His father died of a heart attack soon after.



Cebisile Yawa

He replaced his father as a rock driller, and was 25 years-old when he was killed.



Mafolisi Mabiya

He lies next to his uncle, another platinum miner shot dead while on strike in the 1980s.



Jackson Lehupa

A rock driller whose family are now going hungry while the government and mine do nothing.



Michael Ngweyi

39 years old, from Umtata in the
Eastern Cape.



Mgcineni ‘Mambush’ Noki

The smiling ‘man in the green blanket’ was a 30 year old rock driller and strike leader shot 14 times.



Ntandazo Nokamba

He was 36 years old when he was killed at Marikana on August 16th.



Thabiso Mosebetsane

A 49-year old who had worked long as a gold and platinum miner. His murder left 3 children orphaned.



Bongikosi Yona

A 32 year-old rock drill operator who worked for Lonmin for 2 years before being killed.



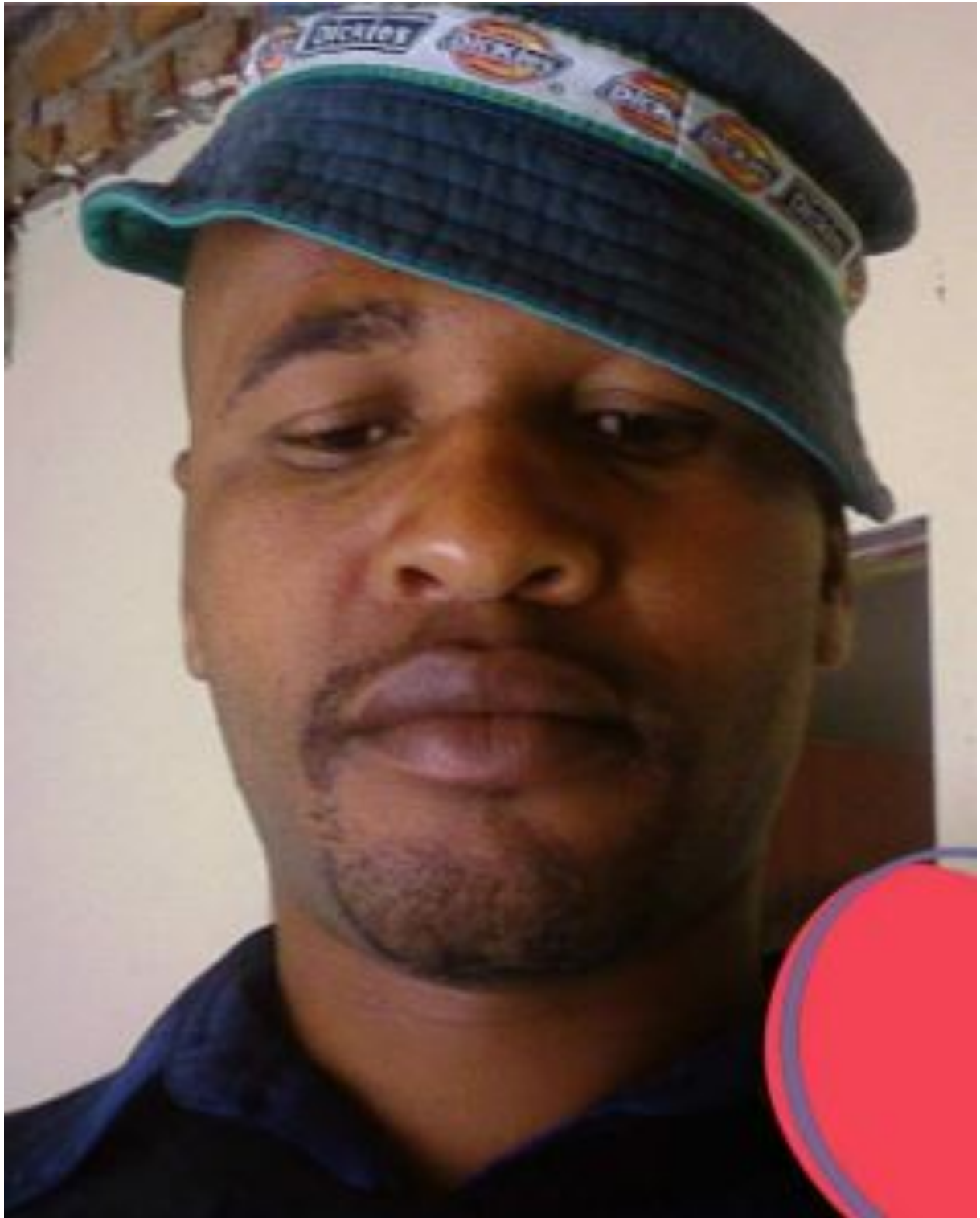
Nkosiyoabo Xalabile

At 31 years, he is survived by his younger brother Mandlekosi (25) who also works at the Lonmin mine.



Fezile Saphendu

A 23 year-old miner who had gone to the mountain to deliver food to his colleagues.



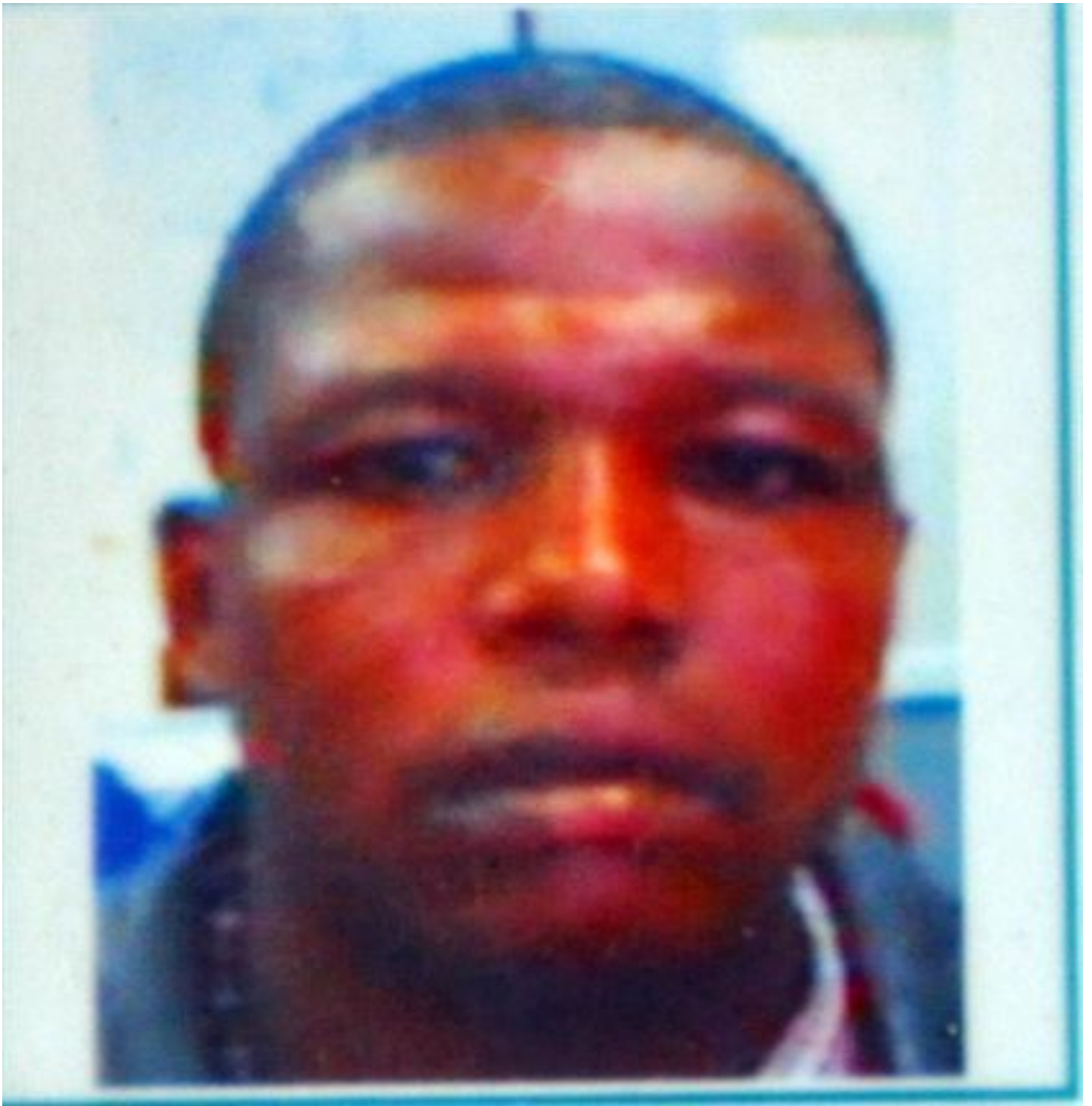
Khanare Monesa

A 39 year-old driller for Lonmin,
murdered on August 16.



John Kutlwano

Legingoane

24years old, worked at Lonmin for 5 years.
Shot twice in the neck and head



Patrick Akhone Jijase

A miner, killed at scene 1, after being shot in the head and forearm by the police.



Mongezeleli Ntenetya

From the Eastern Cape, worked at Lonmin for 12 years. Shot six times by police



Thembinkosi Gwelani

Not employed at Lonmin but had gone to the Koppie to take food to his cousin. Shot in the back of the head by police
